1. The APPLICANT agrees not to release or distribute the raw data in any form to any third party, without written permission from Maryland Department of Natural Resources (MD DNR). Data provided by MD DNR Tidewater Ecosystem Assessment Division is intended only for the project outlined in this data request. Please contact MD DNR if you want to use this data for additional projects.
2. Documents incorporating MD DNR monitoring data and data products shall include explicit reference to the source as follows: "Data included in this document were provided by the Maryland Department of Natural Resources Tidewater Ecosystem Assessment Division."
3. The APPLICANT agrees to provide MD DNR Tidewater Ecosystem Assessment Division with a list of any reports, manuscripts, published papers, or other printed materials prepared using MD DNR Tidewater Ecosystem Assessment Division data, and also provide a copy of such material if requested by MD DNR.
4. Although MD DNR Tidewater Ecosystem Assessment Division maintains high standards of data quality control, MD DNR Tidewater Ecosystem Assessment makes no warranty as to the suitability of our data for the APPLICANT's intended use, nor that the data are complete and free of errors.
